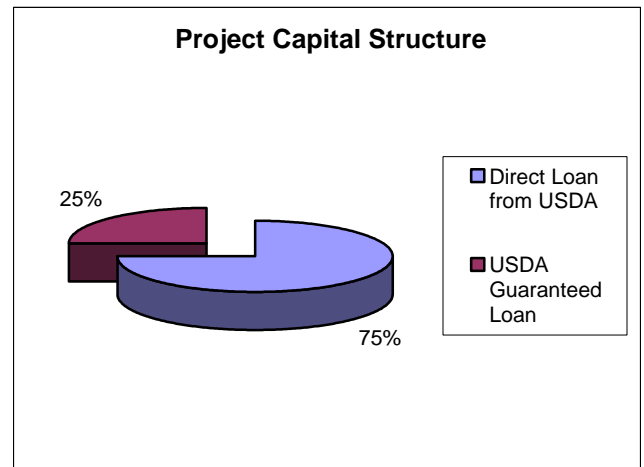


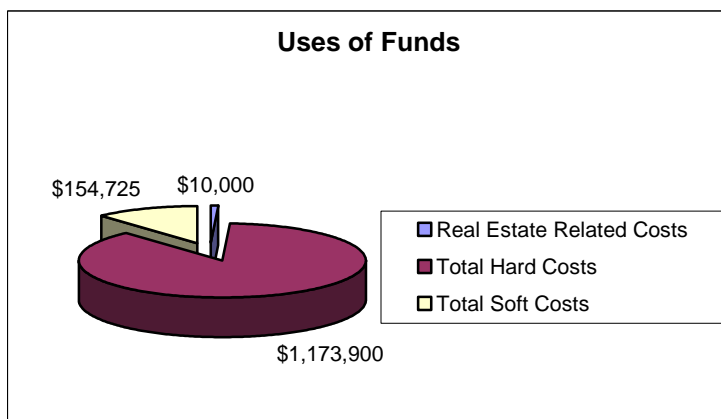
How did Capital Link Help?

Capital Link assisted the health center in receiving funding for the project through USDA's Community Facilities Direct Loan program and Loan Guarantee program. Capital Link helped the center with the USDA application, including forecasted financials and a market analysis. The local USDA office approved the center for a \$1 million, 30-year direct loan at 4.5 percent and a credit guarantee of \$340,000 to guarantee a 25-year bank loan at 6.25 percent. The center also planned to utilize \$250,000 from a line-item appropriation through Senator Bond of Missouri and approximately \$300,000 in tobacco fund money to purchase necessary equipment for the expansion and for potential expansion into an additional facility located south of Ava, Missouri. The health center used an independent grant writer for the appropriations money application.



Sources and Uses of Funds

Projected. The clinic had obtained approximately \$2.3 million in funding for this project, with approximately \$1.3 million earmarked for the new facility and the remainder to be used in the satellite offices.



Actual. During the actual planning and construction phases of this project, the health center found itself with approximately \$1,300 in extra funding and was able to include a helicopter landing pad for quick transport of emergency patients to hospitals located approximately 60 miles away.
