Connecting Health Centers to Capital Resources

Illustrate the impact of your health center on the economy.



Health centers are not only providers of high-quality health care; they are also important contributors to the economic base of each community in which they are located. In addition to providing essential health care, health centers purchase goods and services locally and regionally, employ residents from the community and are anchors for attracting new businesses and investments into the community.

Capital Link has developed the following reports to promote health centers as viable platforms for economic development both locally and at the state level. Capital Link also works with Primary Care Associations to quantify the economic impact of health centers on a statewide basis and to develop plans of action for use of the information.

### Health Center Baseline Analysis

Analyzes an individual health center or health center network's most recent fiscal year performance to estimate their current impact on the community.

### Health Center Capital Project Analysis

Incorporates the Health Center Baseline Analysis with a more complex analysis of:

- the most recent fiscal year performance
- the capital project
- the impact of the center's expanded operations once the new construction is up and running for some time.

### Primary Care Association (PCA) Baseline Analysis

Analyses are completed in collaboration with a state PCA to provide a statewide report and individual analyses for member health centers. Reports may be tailored to meet the PCA's specific needs.
