

Individual Community Health Center

This analysis estimates the impact of a **40% decline** in patient visits at **Individual Community Health Center** as a result of the COVID-19 pandemic, **from March 2020 through March 2021**. It relies on audited financial data in Capital Link's proprietary database, HRSA Uniform Data System (UDS) data for 2019, and 2019 economic impact multipliers from IMPLAN.

Summary Results: Absent immediate remedies, **Individual Community Health Center** is projected to lose **\$8.4M** in revenue over the twelve-month time period. These losses will deplete the minimal reserves of the health center, requiring layoffs of **59** staff members, including front-line providers. Health center closure and job losses will also ripple through local economies, resulting in an additional **\$8.3M** in lost revenue and **46** lost jobs, compounding the crisis in communities that can least afford it. The **\$1.2 million** in one-time COVID-19 relief funding represents the combined awards received by the health center to mitigate COVID-19 related losses and expenses. In addition, the health center received **\$4.4M** in SBA PPP loans.
